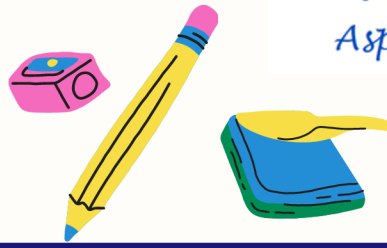

This week in Year 6...

In Maths this week, children have been looking at the past reasoning papers. They have been exposed to the models and strategies of how to approach these papers so that they respond to the questions appropriately. The questions help children to apply their knowledge from the arithmetic paper, they need to continue to practise this at home, to maximise their potential.

In English this week, students have begun publishing their third person narratives focussing on using figurative language and a variety of Alan Pete sentence types independently to increase fluency and cohesion. Students have also been working on a range of grammar/spelling topics in preparation for the SATS.

In our foundation subjects this week we demonstrated an understanding of Baroque music features including what a ground bass is in music. In our Spanish lesson, we were able to answer questions about free time in Spain using the appropriate verb endings. During PSHE, the theme was food choices and the environment issues that food production can cause.
