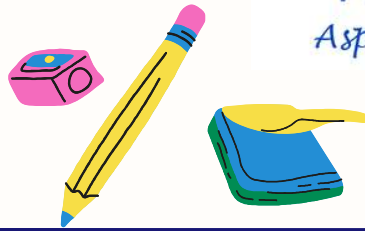

## This week in Year 5...

In English, the children have started our new text the children of Benin Kingdom by Dinah Orji. The children have been introduced to the Kingdom of Benin in West Africa starting in the 900s, during our hook lesson, looking at how the people lived and what artefacts represented during this time. The children also wrote letters to show their understanding of future tense and to make inferences based on the text.

In Maths, the children have been looking at PIXL therapies in order to prepare for the new unit starting next week. Pupils have been looking at identifying 3D shapes, as well as looking at their properties. Furthermore, pupils have looked at measuring angles and worked with using protractors, and identify angles at a point and one whole turn 360 degrees.

In History, the children started to look at the Ancient Greeks, the children looked how democracy was shaped in Athens and how it links to our society today. In Art, looking at constructing their own 3D artwork, using common household items. In RE, they are looking how within the Sikh religion I can list different practices that may perform when someone has died and why certain practices may provide comfort after someone has died.
