## This week in Nursery...

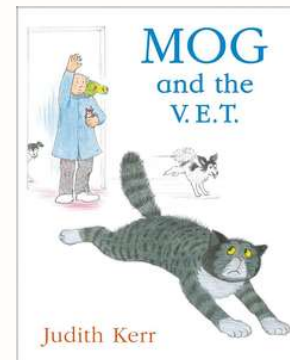
