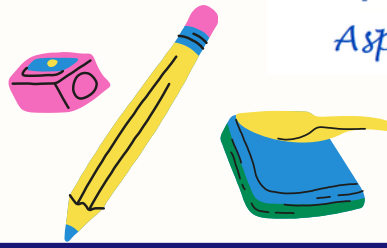

This week in Year 5...



In English, the children have continued with the text *The Odyssey* by Gillian Cross, this is a retelling of the famous story by Ancient Greek author Homer. The children have continued our topic with the final week, where they have been continuing the story, and publishing the beginning, and middle of the story, the ending was set as homework. As well as this the children have been completing lessons on different coordinating and subordinating conjunctions and looking at a grammar paper.

In Maths, the children have finished the unit on statistics, looking and interpreting different representations of data such as line graphs, tables and timetables, and at the end of the week completing the block test.

In History, the children started to look at the Ancient Greeks, the children looked comparing Athens and Sparta, In Art, looking at creating “an explosion of colour and pattern” to decorate the backgrounds.
