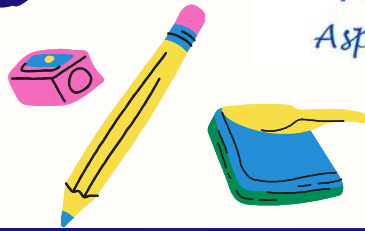

This week in Year 3...

Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

The children have had a wonderful learning journey this week.

In Literacy, we continued with our text: Jim, A Cautionary Tale and the children have explored poetry, the use of syllables in stanzas and rhyming couplets.

In Maths, we have continued exploring the use and application of fractions and how to identify unit fractions and non-unit fractions.

In Science, we have continued learning about Plant Reproduction and explored improving methods and controlling variables in a scientific experiment - focusing on our plant life care experiments in class.

In Geography, the children have continued learning: What was important to ancient Egyptians? This week the children have investigated the beliefs about the afterlife in Ancient Egypt.

In Spanish, we have continued with our topic of Where do you live in Spain? and the children begun practicing identifying language in simple sentences.

In PSHE, we have continued learning about Citizenship and this week we focused on the importance of charities within communities.

In Art, we have continued our learning about Sculpture and 3D: Abstract shape and space. The children were able to use recycled items to explore their creative designs from last week.

In RE, we have begun our new topic of: Are scriptures central to religion? and have explored the use of fire in religious ceremonies.
