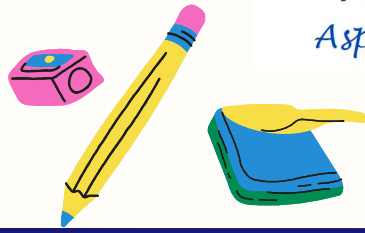

In Maths this week, we have begun measurement. The children have been converting units of measure and ensured they have understood word problems in order to solve them. Arithmetic is still an area of focus to support fluency. Students have been rehearsing the strategies and becoming confident in their explanations.

In English this week, students have worked hard on the creating formal letter of complaint and utilising a wide range of suitable vocabulary. Students have also begun researching countries of their choice with a view to producing a factfile.

We have come to the end of our foundation topic learning for this half term. This week, the children completed making their bags in DT and evaluated the product that they have made. We completed our final lesson on suffering and how different beliefs affect our understanding of suffering. In Science, we looked at how fitness and heart rate are linked.
