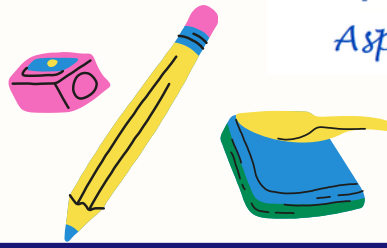

This week in Year 5...



In English, the children have been looking to add information about the characters using dashes for parenthesis, from the book *The children of the Kingdom of Benin*. Additionally, the children have been summarising the events from chapter 15, 16 and 17, using adverbial phrases to link and organise the summaries of each chapter. At the end of the week the children taking all the knowledge from those summaries to answer questions.

In Maths, the children have continued their learning on angles, looking at drawing angles accurately, angles on a point equaling 360 degrees as well as angles on a straight line equaling 180 degrees. Furthermore the children have been continuing at the end of each lesson to work on exam style-reasoning questions related to the topic of the lesson. Additionally, the children have also worked on their application of their arithmetic skills.
