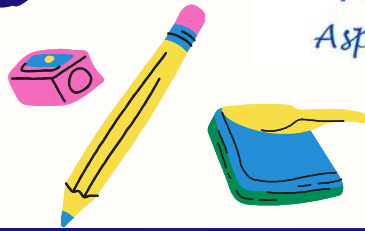

This week in Year 3...

Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

The children have had a wonderful learning journey this week.

- In Literacy, the children created their own rhyming couplets to create a cautionary tale. Please expose your children to poetry at home to allow them to better understand the concept of rhyme.
- In Maths, we have been exploring money, focusing on recognising coins/notes and applying that knowledge to solving word problems.
- In Science, we have continued learning about plants, focussing on the different ways that seeds are dispersed.
- In Geography, the children have continued learning: What was important to ancient Egyptians? This week the children have investigated how burial processes changed throughout the different Egyptian periods.
- In Spanish, we have continued with our topic of Where do you live in Spain? The children created their own postcards, writing sentences about where and who they live with, as well as personal facts about themselves, e.g. favourite colour.
- In PSHE, we have been learning to recognise that charities care for others and identify how people can support them. The children researched different charities of their choosing on Chromebooks.
- In Art, we have continued our learning about Sculpture and 3D: Abstract shape and space. The children recycled materials from last week's sculpture to create a new one based on shapes found in negative and positive spaces.
- In RE, we have begun our new topic of: Are scriptures central to religion? and have explored the use of fire in religious ceremonies. The children explored the symbolism behind the Olympic flame and the torch ceremony.

Thank you to all the parents who continue to support their child with their learning at home. Please ensure your child is reading for at least 10 minutes per day - it has a great impact across ALL their learning.
