## This week in Year 1...

In English, children explored descriptive writing through discussions about dinosaurs and dinosaur fossils. They sequenced events from a story using pictures and time connectives such as first, then, next and finally. Children also developed their understanding of command sentences and imperative verbs by creating pamphlets about caring for the planet.

In Maths, children recapped number bonds, addition and subtraction, and practised writing numbers in words.

In Science, children explored the process of plant development by observing and comparing different shapes and sizes of seeds.

In Art, children applied their painting skills by working in the style of an artist, exploring colour mixing and creating different shades. Using a paper plate, children recreated their own designs inspired by Clarice Cliff's Circle Tree plate, using bright colours to paint circles and finishing with black paint and a straw to blow a tree design.
