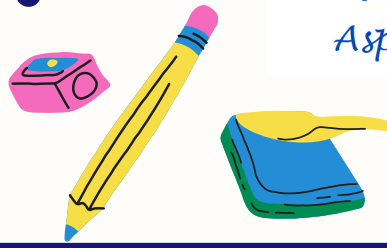

This week in Year 4...

Year 4 have had another busy and engaging week, with the children showing great enthusiasm and effort across all areas of their learning.

In English, the children explored a wide range of writing skills. They wrote in the style of a newspaper report, created stanzas using future tense and a rhyming pattern, and summarised key events while identifying authorial techniques. They also developed their reading skills by appraising texts, giving their own opinions with clear justification, and identifying the key features of a setting description.

In Maths, we continued developing our understanding of decimals. The children worked on making a whole using tenths and hundredths, and explored how to partition decimals, including flexible partitioning to deepen their number knowledge.

In Science, the children made careful observations and used these to support their learning. They also created and used classification keys, helping them to organise and group information effectively. In DT, the children selected ingredients and followed a budget, developing important skills in planning and decision-making. In History, we explored the role of gods in ancient Maya civilisation, helping the children understand the importance of beliefs in shaping people's lives. In Music, the children worked collaboratively to play syncopated rhythms as part of a group, showing great teamwork and timing. In RE, the children explored the importance of Classical Arabic in Muslim beliefs and practices, deepening their understanding of the role of language in religion. Finally, in PSHE, the children learned about the role of groups in the wider community, considering how people work together to support one another.

It has been another fantastic week of learning—well done, Year 4!
