## This week in Nursery...



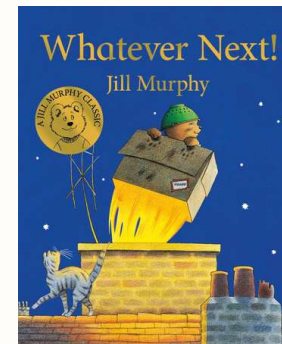
This week in Nursery, we enjoyed learning all about people who help us, we learnt all about Vets! The children explored through play and discussion, supporting their developing language and communication skills during group time. We learnt all about the way vets help us and animals! In maths, we explored patterns! We also learnt the nursery rhyme Incy Wincy Spider with the children joining in enthusiastically with the singing and actions.

After the half term we will be reading the story 'Whatever Next!'. The children will explore space and our imaginations while continuing to develop their language skills through discussion and group time. We will also continue learning about spring and the world cup through a range of engaging, themed activities. In maths we will be exploring shape.

Our nursery rhyme will be 'This is the way we brush our teeth', encouraging the children to join in with singing, counting and actions.

In PE, the children will start their unit focused on Games. We will continue our small-group dough disco and pre-writing shapes activities to strengthen hand skills, and the children are making great progress in recognising, reading and beginning to write their own names.
