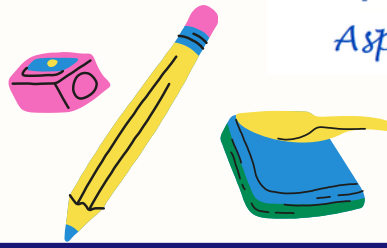

In Maths this week, we have begun the topic of algebra, to get the pupils ready for secondary.
