## This week in Year 1...

In English, children explored the use of the suffixes -s, -es, and -ing to create sentences based on pictures from the wildlife in the woods theme. They developed their understanding of how suffixes change the meaning of words and help to make sentences more descriptive and accurate.

In Maths, children learned about direction, using positional and directional language to describe movement and follow routes. They practised giving and following instructions involving left, right, forwards and backwards.

In Science, children investigated whether taller trees have wider trunks by measuring different trees and recording their findings. They analysed the data collected and looked for patterns to help answer their scientific question.

In Design and Technology, children learned about fruits and explored how to identify them. They sorted a variety of fruits and non-fruits into groups, discussing their features and looking closely at the seeds inside different foods. Children worked collaboratively to classify items as 'fruit' or 'not a fruit' and explained the reasons for their choices.
