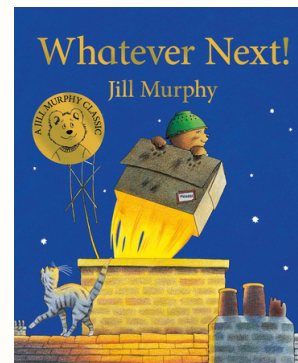
This week in Nursery...

This week in Nursery, we enjoyed learning all about the book *Whatever Next!* The children explored through play and discussion, supporting their developing language and communication skills during group time. We learnt all about space and how to use our imagination! In maths, we have been exploring shape!
