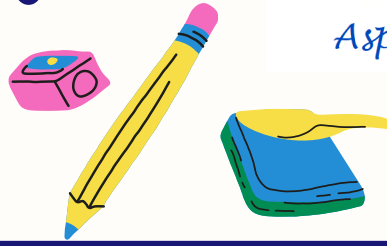

Alongside their assessments, the children have been busy preparing their performances for our oracy showcase based on Roald Dahl. They have enjoyed developing their speaking and listening skills, rehearsing their parts and thinking carefully about how to engage an audience through expression, volume and performance.

We also had a fantastic Carnival Day, with children coming to school dressed in colourful and creative outfits. The day was full of fun, celebration and excitement, and it was wonderful to see everyone embracing the carnival spirit.

In English, the children used synonyms to describe different strengths of emotion and learned how to use the present perfect tense when writing diary entries. In Maths, the children applied their learning through an end-of-unit assessment and began exploring angles as turns, developing their understanding of rotation and direction.

In Science, we revised our learning from the units on states of matter, classification, and changing habitats. The children also planned and carried out a comparative test, applying their scientific enquiry skills.

In Art and Design, the children explored a range of techniques to develop imagery, experimenting with different approaches to create effective visual outcomes. Finally, in PSHE, the children learned about the importance of monitoring money and making responsible financial decisions.

It has been a wonderful week and we are extremely proud of everything the children have achieved. Well done, Year 4!
