This week in Year 1...

In Maths, children began learning about time. They explored how to sequence events in chronological order using language such as before, after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening. They practised discussing daily routines and ordering events correctly.

In English, children experimented with vocal variety and physical gestures to differentiate between characters. Through sensory exploration activities, they developed an initial "word bank" of oral vocabulary and used this to support storytelling. They also worked on sequencing events within a story to strengthen their understanding of narrative structure.

On Tuesday, children enjoyed taking part in Carnival Day activities. They learned about the history of carnivals and explored how carnivals are celebrated around the world. As part of the celebrations, they designed colourful face masks, created their own samba shakers, and participated in an engaging workshop. The children thoroughly enjoyed the experience and embraced the festive atmosphere.

In Design and Technology, children continued their learning about fruits and vegetables. They investigated whether different fruits and vegetables grow above ground or below ground and used their observations to sort and classify them correctly.
