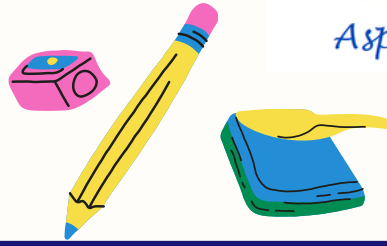

In English, the winners of each class in the Oracy competition, performed in front of the year group to determine the finalist for the next stage of the competition. As well as this, the children have edited their news bulletins from the Kingdom of Benin, and will perform in front of the class.
