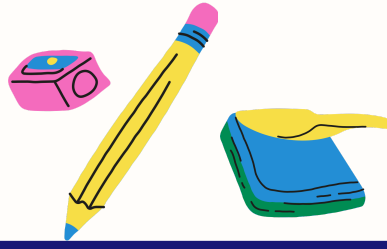

This week in Reception...

This week, we introduced our new class book, *The Night Pirates*. The children were very excited to begin exploring this adventurous story. We spent time looking at the front cover, discussing the title and making predictions about what we thought might happen in the story. The children shared some fantastic ideas and used their imaginations to think about the characters and setting.

In Maths this week, we have been exploring and manipulating shapes. The children have been investigating how shapes can be moved, rotated, turned and combined to create new pictures and patterns. They have enjoyed using a variety of resources to build, arrange and discuss different shapes, while developing their mathematical vocabulary and problem-solving skills.

In Art this week, we linked our learning to our pirate theme and the story *The Night Pirates*. The children enjoyed being creative and using a variety of materials and techniques to create pirate-themed artwork. They explored colours, shapes and textures while developing their fine motor skills and expressing their own ideas and imagination through their art.
