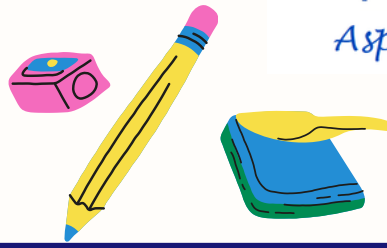

In Maths this week, the children have been revising arithmetic and ensuring they have understood all the efficient methods clearly. They have spent time looking at fractions and ensuring they are confident with all the strategies to solve fraction equations. Long division is still an area of development, which shall be our focus for the upcoming weeks.

In English this week, we have begun to write our first drafts of a newspaper article. We recapped the learning from last week and read the poem again. We then completed a class shared write of our opening and build-up. The children then wrote their own versions.
