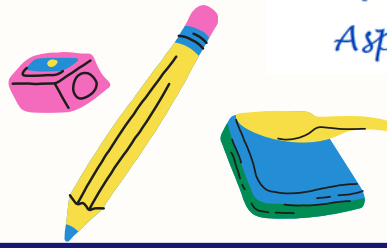

This week in Year 5...

In English, the children have started a new text. A retelling of the famous story of Beowulf, written by Michael Murpurgo. Learning about the legend of Beowulf who defeats a mysterious creature that plays havoc on 5th century Scandavia.

In Maths, the children have been looking at coordinates, reflections, translations and lines of symmetry of various shapes in our position and direction unit. The children have practices using coordinate grids and how to move and navigate when these shapes need to be relocated and or reflected in different positions.

In Music, the children have looked at a variety of different examples of book and jukebox musicals in which they are in groups and are writing a scene from a musical as well as a song to include.
