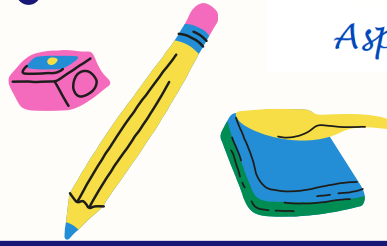

The children have all performed their oracy presentations, showcasing the hard work, confidence and creativity they have developed through our Roald Dahl project. We were incredibly proud of how clearly and confidently they spoke, and how well they engaged their audiences.

The children have also shown tremendous grit and determination during the recent heatwave. Despite the challenging temperatures, they have continued to work hard, stay focused and give their best effort in all areas of their learning.

In English, the children completed their learning on Shackleton's Journey by writing newspaper articles based on the expedition. They worked hard to include key features of newspaper writing, including headlines, factual reporting and eyewitness accounts.

In Maths, we have been learning about shape and space. The children explored the properties of shapes, identified regular and irregular polygons, investigated parallel lines and developed their understanding of different types of angles. In Art and Design, the children experimented with designs using tracing paper and learned new artistic techniques, developing their creativity and attention to detail. In PSHE, we explored the factors that can influence our future career choices, encouraging the children to think about their interests, skills and aspirations. In Geography, the children investigated how rivers are used around the world, considering their importance for transport, farming, industry and recreation. Finally, in Music, the children continued to develop their composition skills by creating and notating their own motifs.
