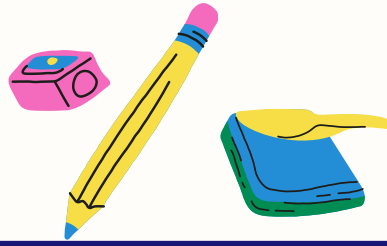

This week in Reception...

This week, we have continued reading our class book, *The Night Pirates*. The children have been enjoying retelling the story and exploring the characters, settings and events in more detail. They worked collaboratively in small groups to role-play different parts of the story, using actions, facial expressions and their voices to bring the characters to life before performing to the rest of the class.

In Maths this week, we have been exploring and manipulating 2D shapes. The children have been identifying and naming different shapes before investigating how they can be cut, combined and rearranged to create new shapes and pictures. They enjoyed experimenting with different ways to join shapes together and discovering that a shape can be divided into smaller shapes and then transformed into something new.

This week in Art, we have been creating summer-themed artwork and sharing ideas about the things we like to do in summer. We have been keeping the children cool this week by encouraging water play, keeping in the shade, no outdoors after 11am, minimal movement, blinds down and windows and doors fully open and keeping their water bottles with them all day.

We are looking forward to reception sports day and picnic, we hope to see of many you there as possible.
