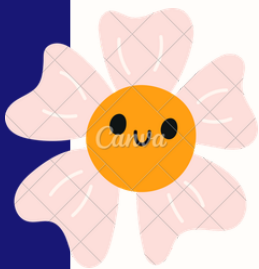


This week in Nursery...

This week in Nursery, we continued our learning around the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The children enjoyed exploring the characters and retelling parts of the story through play, helping to develop their language and communication skills. In maths, we continued learning about shape and explored different 2D shapes through a range of activities. We also learnt the nursery rhyme 'Goldilocks went to the house of the Bears' with the children joining in enthusiastically with the singing and actions.

Next week in Nursery, we will be enjoying Sports Week and taking part in our sponsored bounce! The children will have lots of opportunities to develop their physical skills and teamwork through a range of fun activities. In maths, we will be practising counting beyond 10 and developing confidence with number recognition and counting skills through practical activities and games.
