This week in Year 1...

This week, in maths children have developed their understanding of numbers to 100. They have practised counting forwards and backwards and have explored finding one more and one less than a given number. The children have used a range of practical resources and representations to strengthen their understanding of place value and number relationships.

In English children have planned and written their own narrative stories, carefully organising their ideas into a clear beginning, middle and end. They have focused on sequencing events appropriately and developing their ideas to create engaging stories.

In Science children learned to identify birds that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores by exploring the different foods that birds eat. They applied their learning by using pine cones, fruits and vegetables to create bird feeders, while considering which foods would be suitable for different types of birds.

In PSHE children learned about the important role that different people play in helping to keep us safe. They discussed a range of trusted adults and professionals within the community and explored how these individuals support our health, safety and wellbeing.
