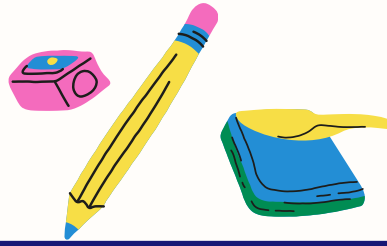

This week in Reception...

This week, we have introduced the children to "The Train Ride". This week, the children have enjoyed exploring the story The Train Ride.

Through a range of exciting activities, they have developed their learning across all areas of the EYFS curriculum.

In Literacy, the children retold the story, sequenced key events, and used descriptive language to talk about the different sights seen from the train. They also learnt new vocabulary related to trains and journeys.

In Mathematics, we have been exploring patterns and continuous patterns. The children created and extended repeating patterns using coloured train carriages and other classroom resources, developing their ability to recognise, copy, and continue simple sequences.

In our art area, the children have been making links between their learning in Mathematics and Literacy. To support our maths learning, they explored patterns and continuous patterns by creating colourful repeating designs using a variety of materials. Linked to our class story, The Train Ride, the children enjoyed painting, collaging, and designing their own trains and train carriages, using their imagination and recalling key events from the story. These activities encouraged creativity while reinforcing their understanding of patterns and developing their storytelling skills.

A huge thank you to everyone who attended our Family Picnic and Sports Day. It was a wonderful event, and the children thoroughly enjoyed taking part in all of the activities. It was lovely to see so many families come together as a community to support and celebrate the children's achievements.
