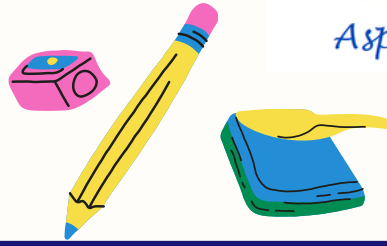

This week in Year 5...

In English, the children continued to look at the text Beowulf and the retelling of this 5th Century Danish tale, written by Michael Murpurgo. This week the children have looked at using prepositions and noun phrases in order to create their own setting descriptions about the famous Heorot (the King's grand hall). In which the Danes held a celebration after Beowulf defeated the monster Grendel. The children looked at combining the senses, along with the overall atmosphere that an event would hold, creating imagery through their setting descriptions.

In Maths, the children have been looking at decimals: adding and subtracting decimals, as well as multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1,000. The children combining their understanding of place value, and the four operations..

In Music, the children have looked at a variety of different examples of book and jukebox musicals in which they are in groups and are performing their created musical scenes as well as a song to include. In science, the children have looked at asteroids and how to design an experiment to understand the size of a crater. In PSHE, with transition day having been this week, the children looked and discussed about the new school year and the roles and responsibilities that come with being in year 6.
