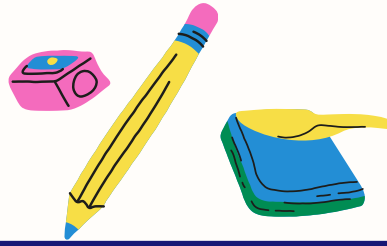

## This week in Reception...

This week, we have continued the "The Train Ride". The children have enjoyed taking part in imaginative role play, pretending to be passengers, ticket inspectors and train drivers, which has helped to develop their confidence, communication and collaborative play. Through drawing and early writing activities, they have been encouraged to describe the different settings and characters they encountered during the train ride, supporting their mark-making and sentence-building skills.

This week in Maths, we have been exploring positional language and prepositions. Through a range of practical, play-based activities, the children have been learning to describe the position of objects using vocabulary such as on, under, over, next to, behind, in front of, between, inside, outside, above and below.

In our Art area, the children have been designing and creating their own trains and different modes of transport inspired by our class book, The Train Ride. They have explored a range of materials and media, including paint, collage, colouring pencils and construction materials, to create colourful and imaginative vehicles. The children carefully thought about the different parts of a train, such as the engine, carriages, wheels and windows, before adding their own creative details and decorations.

We would like to say a heartfelt thank you to all the families who attended our Oracy Performance. It was wonderful to see so many of you there supporting the children and celebrating their achievements. Your encouragement and enthusiasm helped make the event a memorable experience for everyone.
