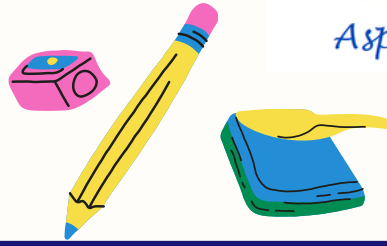

This week in Year 5...

In English, the children continued to look at the text Beowulf and the retelling of this 5th Century Danish tale, written by Michael Murpurgo. This week the children have been creating their own chapter of the Beowulf story. The children created their own monster that Beowulf would have to defeat, they were also given the author decision of whether the hero lives or dies after defeating the monster. They created a front and back cover as well to make it into a book.

In Maths, the children have been looking at negative numbers within a variety of contexts such as temperature on a thermometer, distances and within a sequence. Also, the children have looked at time, understanding reasoning questions that involve a timetables, to gauge how long events or journeys take and to work on understanding how many minutes or hours these may take.

In DT, the children have been cooking a tomato sauce that would be used within a spaghetti Bolognese. The children chopped the ingredients, looked at food hygiene as well. The children worked in their groups, and were successful in making their sauces and were able to sample their cooking. In science, the children completed their experiment to understand the how the size of a astroid would affect the size of the crater within the sand.
