This week in Year 1...

This week, in maths, the children were introduced to money. They explored different coins and notes, learning to recognise and talk about their values. They also enjoyed taking part in role-play shop activities, where they had the opportunity to use money in real-life contexts while developing their counting and problem-solving skills.

In English the children explored poetry and were introduced to acrostic poems. They enjoyed discovering how the first letter of each line can be used to spell a word and had fun creating their own simple acrostic poems using their ideas and imagination.

In Geography, this week, the children learnt about China, with a focus on the city of Shanghai. They explored the physical and human features of the area by looking closely at a range of photographs and discussing what they could see. The children identified features such as rivers, parks and green spaces, as well as buildings, roads and bridges. They enjoyed comparing Shanghai with places they are familiar with and talked about what makes a place a physical or human feature.
