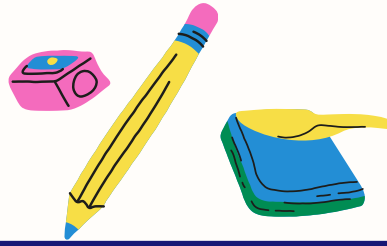

As this is a beautiful wordless picture book, it provides the children with endless opportunities to develop their oracy, imagination and storytelling skills. Throughout the week, the children have been carefully exploring the illustrations.

This week in Maths, we have been exploring maps and direction. The children have been learning how to follow and give simple directions using positional language such as forwards, backwards, left, right, next to, behind and in front of. They have enjoyed using maps to navigate different routes, helping to develop their spatial awareness and problem-solving skills.

In our Art area this week, the children have been using a range of recycled and junk modelling materials to design and create their own modes of transport.

It has been an absolute privilege to watch each child grow in confidence, independence and curiosity throughout their Reception year.
