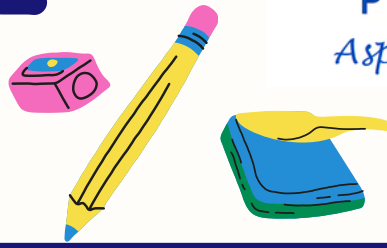

This week in English, the children have been introduced to our new story called Wolves. The children have been learning about wolves using adjectives and creating character descriptions about wolves.
