This week in Year 1...

This week, in Maths, the children have been developing their understanding of numbers to 10. They have practised representing numbers using objects and number lines, counting objects from larger groups and exploring different ways to represent numbers using tens frames. The children have enjoyed using practical resources to develop their counting skills and deepen their understanding of number.

In English, the children have been exploring the story *Whatever Next!* They have practised asking and answering questions, ordering and retelling key events, and sharing their own ideas in full sentences. They have also been developing their early writing skills through composing lists, using capital letters and full stops, and recording their ideas clearly.

In Science, the children were introduced to what science is and explored what scientists do. They discussed how scientists ask questions, make observations and investigate the world around them. The children enjoyed sharing their ideas about what they think scientists do and beginning to develop their understanding of scientific enquiry.
