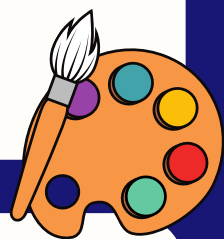
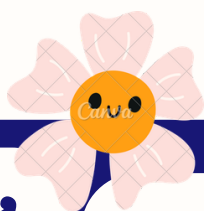

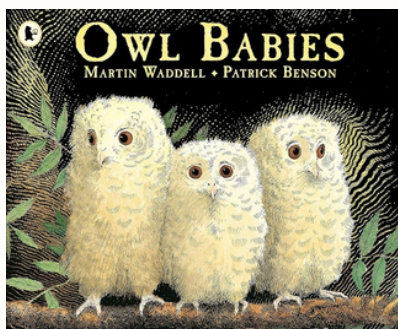
The children have also had their first PE sessions, developing their physical skills through fun activities focusing on jumping, hopping, skipping and moving in different ways.
